

About the MMCSA Scholarship

The MMCSA Scholarship, which have been offered annually since 2000, is open to Instrumentalists and Vocalists aged 12 - 16 years in the year of the scholarship with auditions usually held around September in the year before the scholarships. Three significant financial prizes are awarded to assist talented young musicians realize their potential. Along with the monetary prize, scholarship winners have the opportunity to perform as a supporting artist at MMCSA concerts, sometimes in significant venues. This may involve performing with the backing of a symphony orchestra at our major Annual Variety Concert.

Subject to meeting '*an appropriate standard*' determined by the adjudication panel, three prizes are available:

- First Prize - The MMCSA PRIZE is for \$2000
- Second Prize - The SIEBEN-SCOTT PRIZE is for \$1000
- Third Prize - The JUNE GENDERS AWARD is for \$500
